



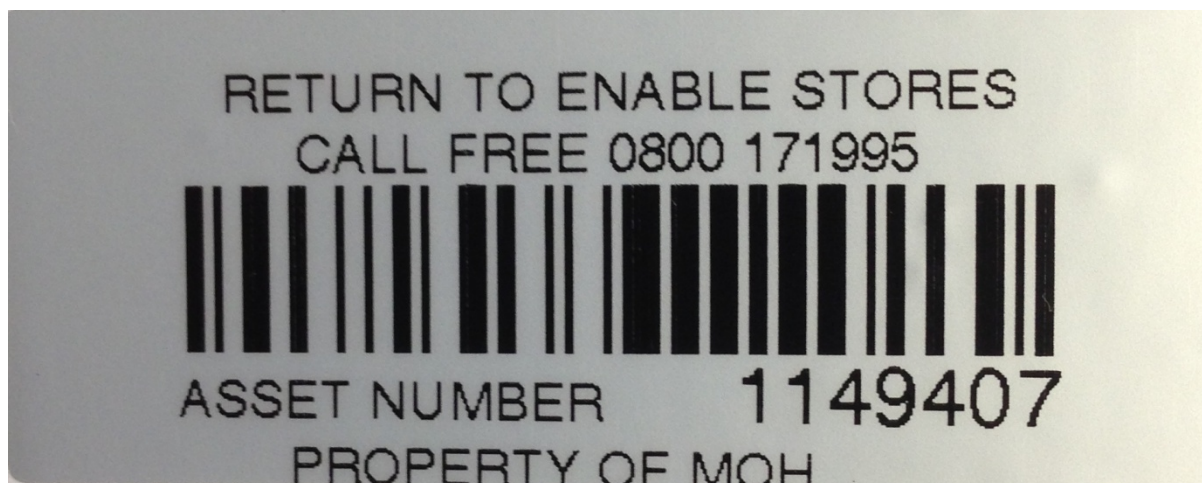
MINISTRY OF HEALTH OWNED EQUIPMENT

The Ministry of Health (MoH) funds the provision of specialised equipment to eligible people with disabilities. This equipment is managed by Service Providers:

Accessible	Auckland / Northland Region
Enable New Zealand	The rest of New Zealand

Once the equipment is no longer required by the eligible user, it remains the property of the MoH and must be returned to the appropriate Service Provider for refurbishment and re-issue.

Such equipment may be identified by means of an Asset Label similar to the sample below:



The Asset Label positively identifies the equipment as “Property of MoH” and also identifies a contact phone number to arrange free collection of the equipment.

From time to time, such equipment is found advertised for sale in shops or on-line. For the most part, the seller is unaware of the legal ownership of the equipment.

In such cases, a copy of this notice should be passed to the seller to encourage them to arrange return of the equipment to the Service Provider. Failure to do so may result in further action.
